Summer session • July 14 - 18 • 8:30a - 11:30a

15 hours of group instruction with a 12:1 student-teacher ratio

This time will allow students to read sample essays, learn about the role of personal statements in the application process, and explore a variety of writing styles and topics useful in the process. This program will provide personal attention to each student.

Fall follow-up session • October 2008

1 hour of one-on-one essay counseling by appointment

Students will make appointments to meet one-on-one with an essay counselor to complete and revise their admission and application essays.
