The San Diego Area Writing Project offers high school juniors and seniors an opportunity to read and write as college students.

July 7 - 11 • 9:00a - 12:00p

15 hours of group instruction with a 12:1 student-teacher ratio

During this five day program students will begin to develop the writing skills and tools necessary to succeed in higher education by reading college-level texts and writing personal, reflective, and critical responses to these texts. Instructors will help students to see their writing from the perspective of a college professor and enable them to develop the resources necessary to deliver the quality of work required in a college course.

The unique demands of the Analytical Writing Placement Exam (formerly the Subject A exam) will be discussed as an example of the challenges students should be prepared for in college.
