

### Assignments for Term Paper Projects

These instructions apply to students doing a project rather than the second batch of reflections and the final. The final project is worth 50% of your final grade. You may submit this work via email ([bmehan@ucsd.edu](mailto:bmehan@ucsd.edu)) or in class. Do not be late!

#### 1. Due TUESDAY May 11:

- (a) **Topic:** Describe the topic of your project in a paragraph up to 1 page. Identify the research question you are investigating as part of this description. Please ensure that the names of all authors are included.
- (b) **Form of Project:** Tell us if you prefer to write a paper or present to the class (on June 8th). We cannot guarantee that we can satisfy all requests to make an oral presentation; if there are too many requests to make oral presentations, we may have to make some of those into written papers.
- (c) **Research Methods:** Describe the research methods that you will be using in your project. *Describe at least one article assigned in class that uses this method.* If you plan to observe in schools or other places, be sure you have permission. If you plan to interview people, I MUST approve your interview questions.

#### 2. Due TUESDAY May 18: Annotated Bibliography-Course material and outside sources:

Identify at least 3 sources from *within* the course and 3 *from outside the course* that you are consulting for your project; identify the author, title, publication information for each source; describe each work in a paragraph or so; explain how each source relates to your project.

#### 3. Due TUESDAY May 25. Outline:

Provide an outline of your paper or presentation. Indicate where the material described in Topic #1c and Topic #2 fits into your presentation or paper.

Final paper is due June 8th. Presentations will take place on June 8th in CH 113. Plan on 15 minutes for each presentation.
